This lesson is about a moving machine with wheels and an engine. A vehicle.

Veh hi cle

Many students pronounce this word with three syllables. They also mispronounce them:

Vay he kle

In fact, this word is pronounced as a two syllable word – the 'i' in the middle is not pronounced:

Veh i cle

Veh is pronounced like *ear* or *near*.

Ear near veer veh

Listen and practise. Repeat after me:

Ear near veer veh veh veh veh

The second syllable, *cle* is pronounced like *pull*.

pull full kull cle

Listen and practice. Repeat after me:

pull full kull cle cle cle cle

Now let's put the two sounds together.

Veh (*veer*) cle (*kull*)

Listen and practise. Repeat after me:

vehicle vehicle vehicle vehicle vehicle

Listen to these questions and answers.

Q: Which *vehicle* would you like to drive?
